1 Typesetting

For this year's UKPEW proceedings we are going to borrow the Lecture Notes in Computer Science (LNCS) style file.

Author instructions for this style can be found at

Please follow these instructions as carefully as possible. In particular:

- If you are using latex then you should use the `lncs.cls` class file (see section 3); if you are using Word then you should use the template `sv-lncs.dot` (see section 4). You must ensure that your paper complies with the formatting instructions specified in section 2.
- Take note of section 2.8 (no page numbers), but not section 2.9 (printing instructions).
- Ignore section 6 (on copyright) but do go through the checklist in section 7.

2 Paper Submission

So that we can make as good a job as possible of the proceedings it would be very helpful if you could submit the source (input) files for your paper, as well as a pdf and a postscript version of the final document.

Once you have all this information together in a directory, tar it all up

```
tar -cvzf paper_XX.tar.gz *
```

using your corresponding submission number in place of *XX*.

Then send the `paper_XX.tar.gz` file to `ukpew03@dcs.warwick.ac.uk`

You should submit your paper no later than **9 June 2003** (this is a hard deadline). Aim to limit your submission to 12 pages.
